FSS is a HUD program to help Housing Choice Voucher Program families obtain education and employment that will lead to economic independence and self-sufficiency.

If you answered Yes to any of these questions, you should attend an FSS informational briefing to learn how to make your plans a reality.

What is the FSS Program?

A five-year voluntary program designed to assist Housing Choice Voucher participants achieve economic independence.

The FSS Program is a self-paced program. You determine your goals, and we help you find the resources needed to become self-sufficient.

Who is eligible?

To participate, a family must be a Housing Choice Voucher participant in the County of Orange.

How does the program work?

The first step is to attend an FSS information briefing.



- ◆ Meet with a Housing Program Specialist to develop your short and long term goals.
- Sign an FSS Contract of Participation.
- Attend workshops and receive referrals to services needed.
- Periodically meet with your Housing Programs Specialist to discuss and evaluate progress,
- Apply for graduation after goals are reached and fulfilling your COP.

What services are offered to families in the FSS program?

- Case management.
- Supportive services.
- Skills training.
- Education planning.
- Employment assistance.

Incentives for participating in the FSS program?

- Education.
- Empowerment & Support.
- Establish an escrow account, which is a savings account created when your rent increase due to an increase in earned income (wages).
- Reimbursement.
- Resources.

How do you graduate from FSS?

You must fulfill the following criteria:

- 1. Complete all goals within five-years.
- 2. Be suitably employed.
- 3. All family members must be free from Cal Works at the time of graduation
- 4. Household must be in good standing with OCHA.

Can the FSS program help families purchase a home?

- The FSS program can refer families to first-time homeownership programs to increase homeownership options.
- We encourage families to use the escrow account savings for the down payment on their first home!
